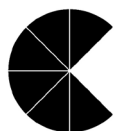

- All content must be G rated.
- Copyright remains with the author.
- Entries may be typed or clearly written on A4 paper.
- Entries may be delivered to any Casey Cardinia Libraries branch or submitted via email to information@cclc.vic.gov.au with the subject line 'Harry Potter Short Story Competition'.
- Entry forms must be submitted with the story. Forms are available at any Casey Cardinia Libraries branch or online at www.cclc.vic.gov.au.
- No entries will be accepted after Thursday 1 June 2017.
- Names should appear on entry forms only.
- Entries will not be returned.
- Winners only will be notified by phone.
- One entry per person only.
- Individual prize pool for Casey Cardinia Libraries members.
- Casey Cardinia Libraries reserve the right to reject entries based on inappropriate content or language.
- Results will be published on the Library website at www.cclc.vic.gov.au and publicly announced at the Harry Potter 20th Anniversary Celebrations on Monday 26 June 2017. Cardinia winners will be announced at Pakenham Library. Casey winners will be announced at Cranbourne Library.
- The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
